Following the On ne va pas se défiler parade for the Seine-Saint-Denis Cultural Olympiad, the MC93 invited the participants in that project and former members of the Petite Troupe to join the Bonne Nouvelle project. We brought together 18 young people aged between 10 and 20 to work with choreographer and dancer Régine Chopinot from February to April on a dance show based on rhythm. Régine Chopinot is accompanied by Bekaye Diaby, who assists her with the choreography, and Valentin Provendier on drums.
