OPEN LAB CONTENT

As part of the *Scène aux Citoyen.ne.s* festival, a dozen young people were invited to take over the stage of the Théâtre de Liège. They are from Liège and represent the voice of an active youth eager for change. They received around one hundred anonymous letters written by 3rd and 4th-year secondary school students from the region. Through these letters, the young people express their feelings about their lives as teenagers and adults, relationships, friendships, love, intimacy, and their vision of the future. As ambassadors of this youth, they deliver the messages and respond to the letters in their own way. Between laughter, tears, and uncertainties, a state of youth is revealed.

This work is the result of collective writing and is the product of writing, video, and theater workshops.
